banquet prepared for all peoples. Amen.**

Acclamation

All With love and compassion,
come, Lord Jesus.

All With judgement and mercy,
come, Lord Jesus.

All In power and glory,
come, Lord Jesus.

All In wisdom and truth,
come, Lord Jesus.
