

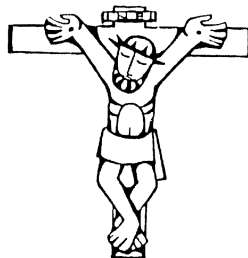
# The LENT All Age Eucharist

**All** The Lord be with you

Lift up your hearts.

**All** We lift them to the Lord.

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

**All** It is right to give thanks and praise.

It is always right, wherever we are, to give you thanks and praise, God our Father, holy and strong, king for ever.

Through your Son, you made us and the whole universe. When his time had come, Jesus suffered, and died on the cross, to save us from our sins.

You send your Spirit to bring new life to the world, and fill us with power from on high. And so we join on earth with saints and angels in heaven to praise your name and *sing*:

**All** Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might,  
heaven and earth are full of your glory.  
Hosanna in the highest.  
Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.  
Hosanna in the highest.

Father, on the night before he died, Jesus had a meal with his friends. He took the bread, and thanked you.

He broke it, gave it to them and said:

Take this and eat it; this is my body, given for you.

After the meal, Jesus took the cup of wine. He thanked you, gave it to them and said:

Drink this, all of you. This is my blood, the new covenant of God's love. Do this to remember me.
