communion in Christ's body once broken

we shall reign with him.**

Giving of Communion

Before the distribution the president says

All Jesus is the Lamb of God
who takes away the sin of the world.
Blessed are those who are called to his supper.
**Lord, I am not worthy to receive you,
but only say the word, and I shall be healed.**

The president and people receive communion.

After a silence a prayer may be said before we say together

All **Faithful God,
may we who share this banquet
glory in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ,
our salvation, life and hope,
who reigns as Lord now and for ever.
Amen.**

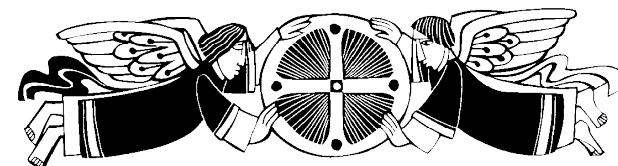
The Clarendon Team Prayer
