

Giving of Communion and Laying on of Hands

offered to any who seek it during the time of communion. Please
bring the card you have been given to indicate this. A set form of
words will be used.

A more specific and personal Prayer Ministry will be offered, 6
in complete confidence, by two Prayer Ministers in the North Aisle.

Before the distribution the president says

Alleluia! Christ our Passover
is sacrificed for us.

All **Alleluia! Let us keep the feast.**

The president and people receive communion.
During the distribution hymns and anthems may be sung.
