Gospel Reading

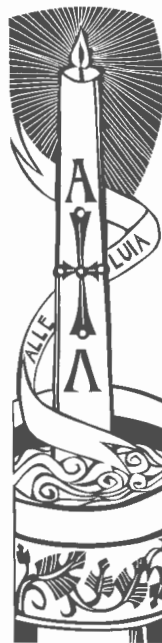
*When the Gospel is announced

Please remain standing for the Eucharistic Prayer

The Eucharistic Prayer (Prayers A, D or G)

All The Lord be with you
and also with you.
Lift up your hearts.
All **We lift them to the Lord.**
Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.
All **It is right to give thanks and praise.**



*The president praises God for his mighty acts
and all respond*

All **Holy, holy, holy Lord,
God of power and might,

Hosanna in the highest.
Blessed is he who comes
in the name of the Lord.

*The prayer continues and includes
one of the following acclamations*

*The Prayer continues and leads into the Doxology,
to which all respond*

All **Blessing and honour and glory and power
be yours for ever and ever. Amen.**

*Please KNEEL or SIT We have a time for private prayer,
reflection and meditation.*

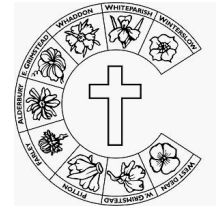
The Clarendon Team Prayer

in Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen**

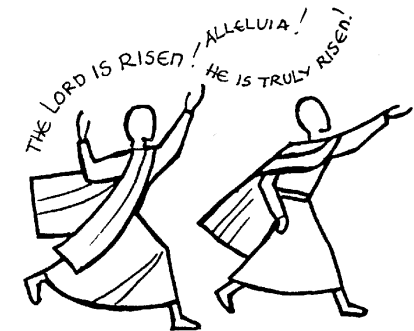
Blessing
