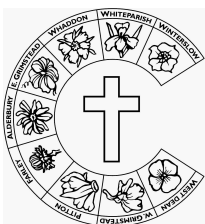


# The Eucharist on Pentecost Sunday

**Glory to you, O Lord.**

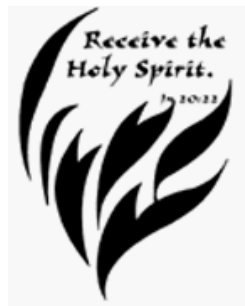

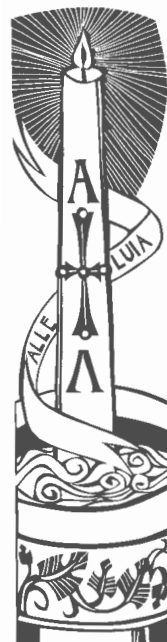

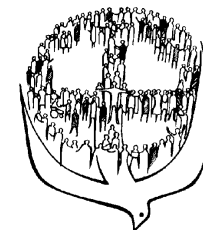
## Preparation of the Table

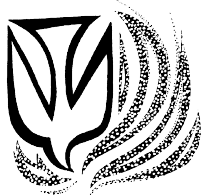

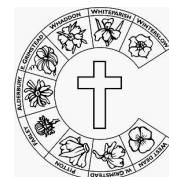
