The Greeting (stand)

The president greets the people

The Lord be with you
All **and with thy spirit.**

Words of welcome or introduction may be said.

Prayer of Preparation (Kneel)

All **Almighty God,**
unto whom all hearts be open,
all desires known,
and from whom no secrets are hid:
cleanse the thoughts of our hearts
by the inspiration of thy Holy Spirit,
that we may perfectly love thee,
and worthily magnify thy holy name;
through Christ our Lord. Amen.

Prayers of Penitence (Kneel)

We are invited to confess our sins

All **Almighty God, our heavenly Father,**
we have sinned against thee
and against our neighbour,
in thought and word and deed,
through negligence, through weakness,
through our own deliberate fault.
We are heartily sorry
and repent of all our sins.
For the sake of thy Son Jesus Christ,
who died for us, forgive us all that is past,
and grant that we may serve thee
in newness of life to the glory of thy name.
Amen.



Gloria in Excelsis (omitted in Advent & Lent)

All **Glory be to God on high,**
and in earth peace, goodwill towards men.
We praise thee, we bless thee,
we worship thee, we glorify thee,
we give thanks to thee for thy great glory,
O Lord God, heavenly King,
God the Father almighty.
O Lord, the only-begotten Son,
Jesus Christ: O Lord God, Lamb of God,
Son of the Father, that takest away the
sins of the world, have mercy upon us.
Thou that takest away the sins of the world,
receive our prayer.
Thou that sittest at the right hand of God
the Father, have mercy upon us.
For thou only art holy;
thou only art the Lord;
thou only, O Christ,
with the Holy Ghost,
art the Most High,
in the glory of God the Father. Amen.

The Collect (Kneel)

*The president introduces a period of silent prayer with
the words 'Let us pray' or a more specific bidding. The
Collect is said.*

All **Amen.**

Readings (Sit)

At the end the reader may say

This is the word of the Lord.

All **Thanks be to God.**

Gospel Reading (Stand)

When the Gospel is announced, the reader says

Hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ
according to N.

All **Glory be to thee, O Lord.**

This is the Gospel of the Lord.
All **Praise be to thee, O Christ.**

The Creed

All **I believe in one God the Father almighty,**
maker of heaven and earth,
and of all things visible and invisible:
And in one Lord Jesus Christ,
the only-begotten Son of God,
begotten of his Father before all worlds,
God of God, Light of Light,
very God of very God,
begotten, not made,
being of one substance with the Father,
by whom all things were made;
who for us men and for our salvation
came down from heaven,
and was incarnate by the Holy Ghost
of the Virgin Mary,
and was made man,
and was crucified also for us
under Pontius Pilate.
He suffered and was buried,
and the third day he rose again
according to the Scriptures,
and ascended into heaven,
and sitteth on the right hand of the Father.
And he shall come again with glory
to judge both the quick and the dead:
whose kingdom shall have no end.

And I believe in the Holy Ghost,
the Lord, the giver of life,
who proceedeth from the
Father and the Son,
who with the Father and the Son together
is worshipped and glorified,
who spake by the prophets.
And I believe one holy catholic
and apostolic Church.
I acknowledge one baptism
for the remission of sins.
And I look for the resurrection of the dead,
and the life of the world to come. Amen.

Preparation of the Table

Taking of the Bread and Wine

The gifts of the people may be gathered and presented. The table is prepared and bread and wine are placed upon it. The president takes the bread and wine. The response to the prayers is

All **Blessed be God for ever.**

The Eucharistic Prayer (Kneel)

All The Lord be with you
and with thy spirit.

All Lift up your hearts.
We lift them up unto the Lord.

All Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.
It is meet and right so to do.

The president continues the preface until ...

..... evermore praising thee and saying:



All **Holy, holy, holy, Lord God of hosts,
heaven and earth are full of thy glory.
Glory be to thee, O Lord most high.
Blessed is he that cometh
in the name of the Lord.
Hosanna in the highest.**

The prayer continues until...

All Great is the mystery of faith:
**Christ has died:
Christ is risen:
Christ will come again.**

The prayer continues until

All O Father almighty, world without end.
Amen.

The Lord's Prayer

Let us pray with confidence as our Saviour has taught us

All **Our Father, who art in heaven,
hallowed be thy name;
thy kingdom come; thy will be done;
on earth as it is in heaven.
Give us this day our daily bread.
And forgive us our trespasses,
as we forgive those who trespass against us.

Giving of Communion

All **We do not presume
to come to this thy table, O merciful Lord,
trusting in our own righteousness,
but in thy manifold and great mercies.
We are not worthy so much as to gather up
the crumbs under thy table.
But thou art the same Lord
whose nature is always to have mercy.
Grant us therefore, gracious Lord,
so to eat the flesh of thy dear Son Jesus
Christ and to drink his blood,
that our sinful bodies may be made clean by
his body and our souls washed through his
most precious blood, and that we may
evermore dwell in him and he in us.
Amen.**

We are invited to receive communion.

The president and people receive communion.

Prayer after Communion (Kneel)

Silence is kept.

A prayer may first be said then we pray together

All **Almighty God,
we thank thee for feeding us with the body
and blood of thy Son Jesus Christ.
Through him we offer thee our souls and
bodies to be a living sacrifice.
Send us out in the power of thy Spirit
to live and work to thy praise and glory.
Amen.**
